Skype

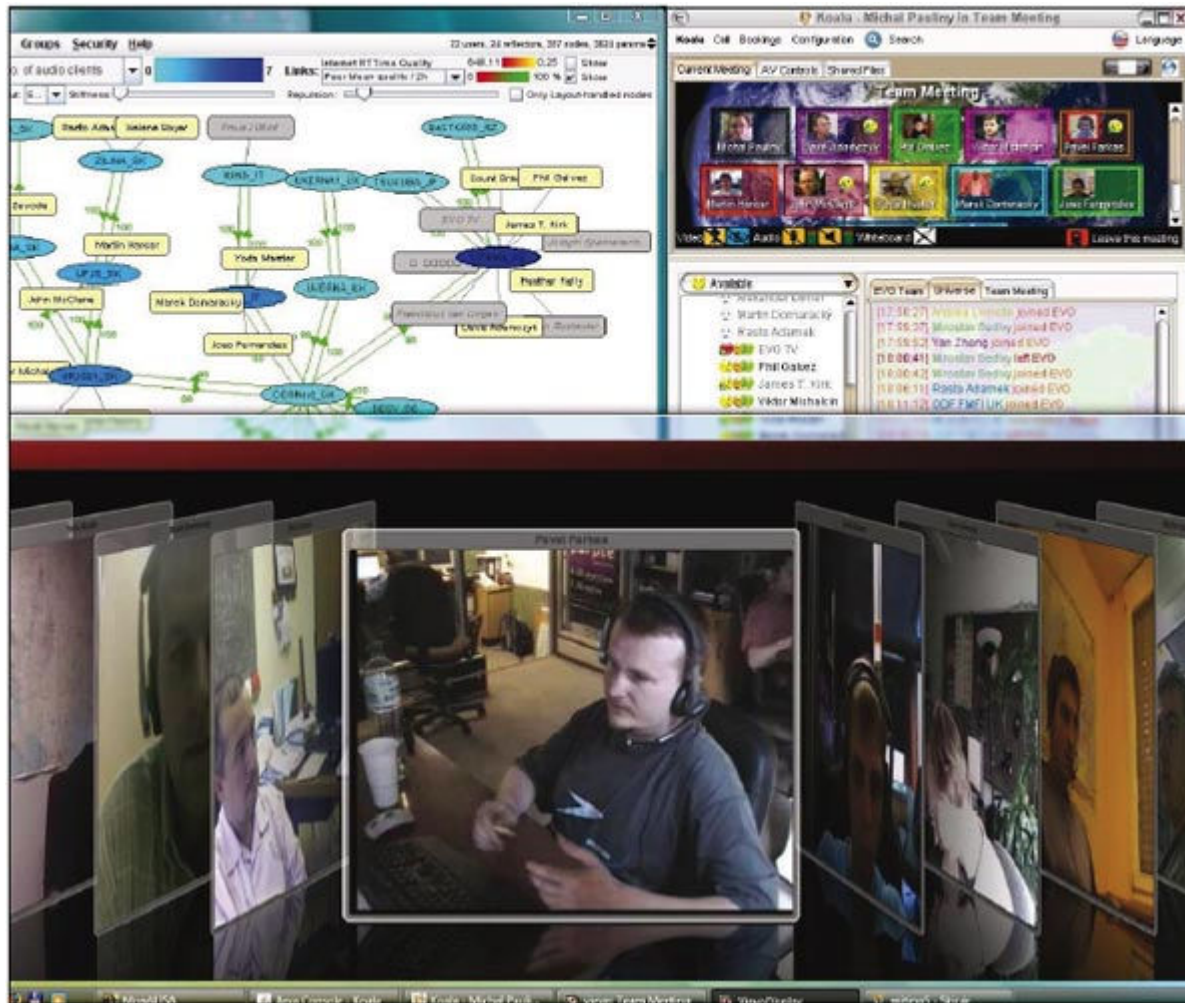


- Download the latest version of the program from <http://www.skype.com/>
- Save it to a temporary directory
- Currently there is a version for Linux, Windows and Mac (present version is 5.1, it includes the possibility of multiple video calls)
- Mobile (iPhone, android) and even TV versions exist
- Windows XP, Vista and Windows 7 is supported
- Install the code (select working language)
- Select and register your skype name and find your colleagues on skype using their e-mails or their name

Some nice features

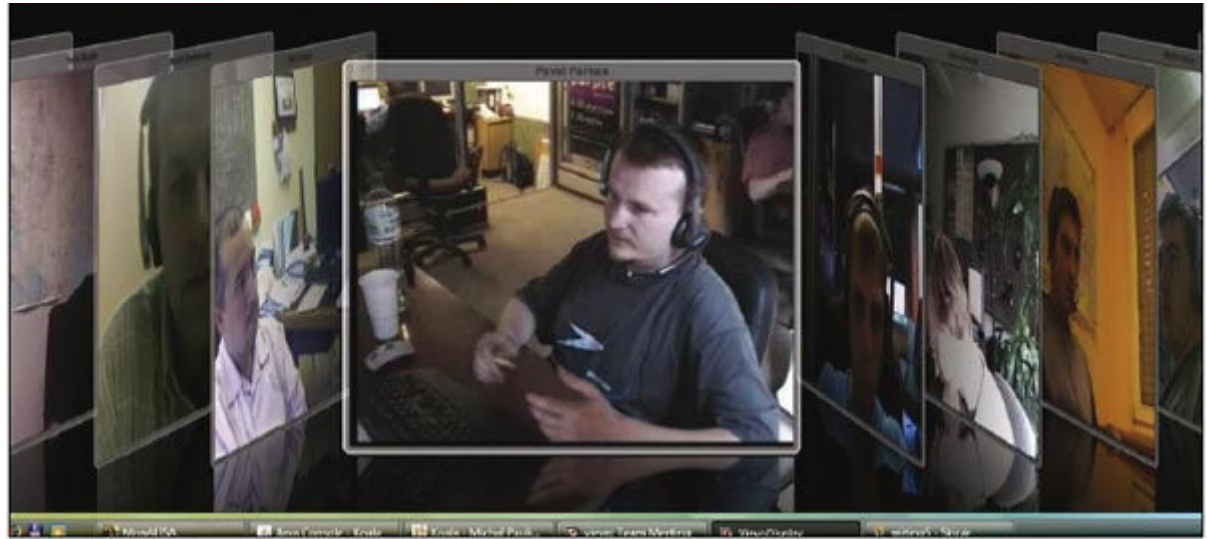
- Free (video) calls between skype users
- Telephone and videoconferencing possibility
- Cheap rates to call landlines or cell phones
- Instant messaging during the calls
- Possibility to send and to receive files during calls
- Possibility to send sms when needed
- Simple design, even grandparents can use it
